Phone Management - allows you to control calling features for your phone that you are subscribed to through NATCO. Under the My Settings tab, go to Phone Management under Categories. Features that you have subscribed to will show in the Settings area. To control the feature, highlight the arrow in front of the item in the list by clicking on it.

Selective Call Rejection - allows you to reject calls that meet your predefined criteria. With Selective Call Rejection, you may choose to reject a list of up to 12 specific phone numbers. Check the "Enable Service" box by clicking in the box. Assign a number you would like to add to the rejection list in the center box by either clicking on the arrow to the right of "Add the last calling number" or by entering the number in the box and clicking on the arrow to add to the list. Click on the green save button in the lower right corner of your screen below the list to save your changes.

Selective Distinctive Ringing - provides special ringing or Call Waiting notification (if you are subscribed to the service) for calls received from those numbers on your specified list of numbers. Under Settings, check the "Enable Service" box by clicking in the box. Assign a number you would like to correspond with the ring by either clicking on the arrow to the right of "Add the last

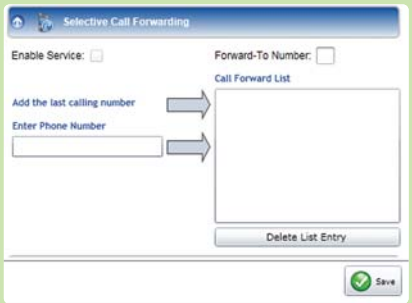

calling number” or by entering the number in the box and clicking on the arrow to add to the list. Click on the green save button in the lower right corner of your screen below the list to save your changes.

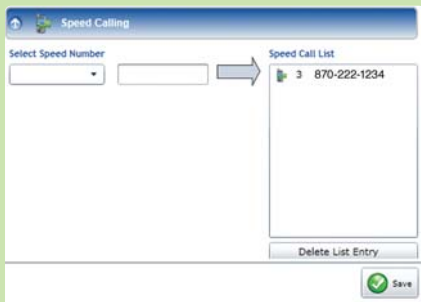
Selective Call Forwarding - allows you to forward specific calls matching your predefined list to a different phone number. Check the “Enable Service” box by clicking in the box. To enter the number at which you would like to receive forwarded calls, click in the box “Forward-To Numbers” and enter the phone number. To add a phone number to the list of calls you want forwarded, either click on the arrow to the right of “Add the last calling number” or enter the number in the box and click on the arrow to add to the list. To delete a number from the list, highlight it and click the “Delete List Entry” button below the list. Click on the green save button in the lower right corner of your screen to save your changes.



Simultaneous Ring - allows you to have multiple destinations ring simultaneously when any calls are received on your phone number. The first destination to be answered is connected. Check the “Enable Service” box by clicking in the box. To create a list of numbers that will ring simultaneously when a call comes in, click on “Add the last calling number” or enter the number in the box and click on the arrow. To delete a number from the list, highlight it and click the “Delete List Entry” button below the list. Click on the green save button in the lower right corner of your screen to save your changes.



Speed Calling - allows you to establish a list of frequently called numbers and assign a one- or two-digit code to access a particular number on the list. In the settings box, assign a code from the blue drop-down menu on the left. Next, enter the number you would like to correspond with that code in the center box. Click on the arrow to add to the list. To delete a number from the list, highlight it and click the “Delete List Entry” button below the list. Click on the green save button in the lower right corner of your screen below the list to save your changes.



Selective Call Acceptance - screens incoming calls against a list of numbers you specify and then accepts calls from only those numbers on the list. To activate the feature, check the “Enable Service” box by clicking in the box. To add numbers to the list of calls you would like to accept, you can enter numbers one of two ways. To add the most recent number used, “Add the last calling number” by clicking the button. To enter a new number to the list, input the number with area code in the box and click on the arrow. To delete a number from the list, highlight it and click the “Delete List Entry” button below the list. Click on the green save button in the lower right corner of your screen to save your changes.
